PASSPORT TO ADVENTURE

Passport to Adventure is an outdoor camp, "No Child Left Inside," located in Crestview Park, just west of Crestview Community Center, (based out of Crestview Shelter House), and is licensed by the State of Kansas. Campers will participate in a wide variety of activities, make new friends, and learn new skills.

Dates: May 30, 2017 to August 4, 2017. No camp May 29 and July 4.

Camp Hours: 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. Pre Care begins 7:15 a.m. & Post Care until 5:30 p.m.

Weekly fee \$110. A \$20 non-refundable registration fee per week is due at time of registration, 10 days prior to camp, the remaining weekly fee of \$90 must be paid.

What to bring daily to camp: A backpack, a reusable water bottle, swimsuit/towel, sunscreen, bug spray, lunch and a drink in a cooler (refrigeration is not available). Campers need to wear tennis shoes. Campers should mark their names on all belongings

Two snacks are provided daily.

Field trips: PTA will use busses to go on field trips and to local pools.
