Established in 1932, the Reinisch Rose Garden features 350 varieties of roses totaling more than 5,500 plants. The garden includes both newly released rose varieties and numerous unusual varieties no longer commercially available. Once the winner of Better Homes and Gardens Magazine's "More Beautiful America" contest, the garden is a popular wedding spot. The adjacent Doran Rock Garden is home to part of Topeka's Tulip Time each spring.
