Tulip Time bulb sale set for May 4

TOPEKA, KAN. – The annual Tulip Time bulb sale is set for May 4 from 9 a.m. to noon in the trailhead parking lot at Ted Ensley Gardens at Lake Shawnee.

- All single bulbs will be packaged in bundles of 20 for \$2.
- Double bulbs will be packaged in bundles of 20 for \$5.

Due to the cold this year, only the best bulbs will be packaged for sale. Those that were damaged by the cold will be not be sold.

The tulip bulb sale helps recover some of the cost of putting on Tulip Time which is made possible by the Shawnee County Parks and Recreation Foundation.
