

General Pool Rules

- All patrons entering must pay an admission fee, regardless of intent to swim.
- Children under 10 must be accompanied by a guardian of at least 13 years of age.
- No running, cursing, pushing, wrestling, fighting, disruptive behavior, distracting lifeguards, and diving or flipping from pool edge.
- Obey lifeguard & pool staff commands at all times.
- No tobacco products, drugs, alcohol, and glass permitted.
- Patrons under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be admitted.
- Swimmers must be clothed in proper swim attire. Questionable attire is at the discretion of management.
- Children requiring floatation support must be within arms-reach of a guardian at all times. Floatation support must be coast guard approved.
- Disposable or cloth diapers are prohibited in pool. Non potty-trained children must wear a swim diaper.
- No free swimming in dive well.
- Shawnee County Parks & Recreation and its staff are not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- Management reserve the right to close the pool during inclement weather, low attendance, emergencies, special events, or circumstances beyond our control.
