The Garfield shelter house is an enclosed shelter located at Garfield Park. The park offers a swimming pool, a walking trail and nearby play equipment. The size of the shelter and space in the banquet area offers many options for set-up. It has tall beamed ceilings and stone walls throughout. There is a large fireplace that offers a nice focal point to the shelter, however it is not usable. Comparable shelters include Crestview (pg.27), Lakewood (pg.29) and Reynolds Lodge (pg.4).

Capacity: 180. **Seating:** 128 chairs (metal folding, tan). **Tables:** 20 (8' x 2.5') rectangle.

Banquet Room Size (approximate): 40' x 71' (2840 sq. ft).

Kitchen: Large separate kitchen that has its own outdoor entrance. Approx. counter space is 2' x 10.5' and 2' x 7.5'.

There is also a 2.5' x 10' island in the banquet area (moveable). An oven and industrial refrigerator available for use.

Restrooms: 2 multi-stall restrooms available.

Outlets: 16 Total - 8 banquet area, 6 kitchen and 1 in each restroom.

Heat and A/C: Yes. **Fireplace:** Unusable.

Outdoor Space: Gated patio (15' x 40') at front entrance.

Outdoor Seating: No.

Grill: Nearby (public). **Playground:** Nearby.
