

SHELTER HOUSE #5

3225 SE TIN MAN CIRCLE



Shelter House #5 is an open-air shelter located on the east side of the lake, in Tin Man Circle. This wooden shelter is surrounded by many beautiful trees and Lake Shawnee can be seen directly behind the shelter. It is partially covered, and can accommodate 120 people. The shelter is available from April 15th – October 15th. Restrooms are located across the street. Comparable shelters include Shelter House #1 (pg.10), Shelter House #4 (pg.11) and Steak Grill (pg.23).

Capacity: 120. **Seating:** 12 (8' x 2.5') total picnic tables. Only 5 of which are located under the roof.

Approximate size: 2190 total sq. ft, of which only 448 sq. ft is covered.

Restrooms: Public restroom (Tin Man) located across the street.

Outlets: 2 Total.

Heat and A/C: No, shelter not enclosed. **Fireplace:** No.

Outdoor Space: N/a.

Outdoor Seating: N/a.

Grill: Yes (2.5' x 3') located on uncovered portion.

Playground: Large playground located across the street, short distance from shelter.
