

SHELTER HOUSE #4

3128 SE TIN MAN CIRCLE



Shelter House #4 is an open-air shelter located on the east side of the lake, in Tin Man Circle. The shelter is surrounded by flower beds, open green space and offers a beautiful view of Lake Shawnee. It is quite spacious and accommodates 120 people. The shelter is available from April 15th – October 15th. There is a public restroom next to the shelter. Comparable shelters at Lake Shawnee include Shelter House #1 (pg.10) and Shelter House #5 (pg.12).

Playground: Large playground located across the street from the restroom, short distance from shelter.
