

WEATHER POLICY

- The facility management team will be able to clear the pool for any of the following:
 1. The facility will not open and can close to the public if the air temperature is not a minimum of 70-degrees. The facility will remain closed until air temperatures reach the minimum 70-degree threshold up to 2pm, in which case the facility will remain closed for the remainder of the day.
 2. In the event that thunder is heard or lightning is seen, the pool will be cleared of all patrons, and will be kept clear until 30 consecutive minutes have passed without hearing thunder or seeing lightning. (The 30-minute clock will restart after each occurrence.)
 3. If heavy rain is present and there is poor visibility of the bottom of the pool, patrons will be asked to clear the pool until the rain subsides and visibility improves.
 4. If local weather reports indicate the presence of severe inclement storms approaching, the pool/facility will close.
 5. If the National Weather Service issues a tornado watch, patrons will be notified and informed of the tornado warning procedure with the facility's public address system.
 6. If the National Weather Service issues a tornado warning all remaining staff and patrons are to immediately proceed to an emergency shelter.
- No new admissions will be permitted when the pool is cleared/closed for any of the above reasons.
- Patrons who arrived at the aquatic facility 2 hours or less before the pool was cleared who wish to leave may receive a rain check.
 - At the time the pool is deemed safe to resume swimming, no further rain checks will be issued.
- The pool will close for the remainder of the day if the pool is cleared for 2 consecutive hours.
