

## SHELTER HOUSE #4

3128 SE TIN MAN CIRCLE



Shelter House #4 is an open-air shelter located on the east side of the lake, in Tin Man Circle. The shelter is surrounded by flower beds, open green space and offers a beautiful view of Lake Shawnee. It is quite spacious and accommodates 120 people. The shelter is available from April 15<sup>th</sup> – October 15<sup>th</sup>. There is a public restroom next to the shelter. Comparable shelters at Lake Shawnee include Shelter House #1 (pg.9) and Shelter House #5 (pg.11).

**Restrooms:** Public restroom (Tin man) next to shelter.

**Outlets:** 1 Total.

**Heat and A/C:** No, shelter not enclosed.      **Fireplace:** No.

**Outdoor Space:** N/a.

**Outdoor Seating:** N/a.

**Grill:** Yes (3' x 3') on uncovered portion of shelter.

**Playground:** Large playground located across the street from the restroom, short distance from shelter.
